- Midtown Phillips is comprised of 6 districts and the boundaries are between East 24th Street to the north, East Lake Street to the south, Bloomington Avenue to the east, and Chicago Avenue to the west.
- **Candidates must live, own property, or represent a business or organization within the neighborhood boundaries as listed below.**
- **Only one vote permitted per business or organization.**
- **Must be 18 years old.**

- Midtown Phillips Board President—1-year term (anywhere in Midtown Phillips)
- District 1, 1-year term: 24th to 26th & Chicago to 12th Avenue
- District 2, 2-year term: 24th to 26th & 12th Ave to Bloomington Ave
- District 3, 1-year term: 26th to 28th & Chicago to 12th Avenue
- District 4, 2-year term: 26th to 28th & 12th Ave to Bloomington Ave
- District 6, 2-year term: 28th to Lake & 12th Ave to Bloomington Ave
- At Large Representative—2-year term (anywhere in Midtown Phillips)
- At Large Representative—2-year term (anywhere in Midtown Phillips)



### MEMBER BYLAWS:

Section 2.1 The membership of the corporation shall consist of one class of members. All persons 18 years of age or older who live in or own property in the geographic area of south Minneapolis, Minnesota, which is defined by the City Planning and Economic Development (CPED) or its successors as “Midtown Phillips,” qualify for membership.

Section 2.2. Members of the Midtown Phillips Neighborhood Association, Inc. are entitled to vote and have equal rights and preferences in matters not otherwise provided for by the Board. There shall be one class of members defined as follows:

A. Resident Voting Members. Homeowners and tenants, 18 years of age or older, who live within the Midtown Phillips geographic area.

B. Non-Resident Voting Members. Any of the following individuals who do not live within the Midtown Phillips geographic area: owners of residential non-homestead real estate located within the Midtown Phillips geographic area; owners of commercial real estate located within the Midtown Phillips geographic area; representatives of not-for-profit business organizations located within the Midtown Phillips geographic area and owners of for-profit business organizations located within the Midtown Phillips geographic area.
