TOPICS:

- Hennepin County 'Safe Communities' presented by Lisa Bayley and her colleagues Antonio Smith, Hennepin County Gun Violence Prevention Coordinator, and Ifrah Jama, Hennepin County Anti-Hate Program Coordinator. They will present a brief overview of the new area at Hennepin County, 'Safe Communities', which brings together the violence prevention work happening around Hennepin County.
- Latasha Jennings is the newly hired Project Manager for LEAD/Let Everyone Advance with Dignity, a community-centered approach to public safety. Focused on the East Lake Street corridor, LEAD will provide harm reduction-based, intensive case management to individuals who come into repeated contact with law enforcement due to unmet behavioral health needs, homelessness, and/or extreme poverty. The LEAD program was brought to Minneapolis by the GreenLight Fund Twin Cities who, through a community-engaged process, identified public safety as a high community priority and selected the LEAD program to help address this need.
- Sam Nyenhuis (Senior Probation Officer, Neighborhood Unit-3rd Precinct) and Connor Machemehl (Probation Officer, Neighborhood Unit-3rd precinct) will discuss their role in probation, community engagement, and public safety.
- Green Central Elementary Safe Routes to School - Kristian Zimmerman, Minneapolis Public Works
